## What's the bottom line?

Total funds raised **£21,000** that's up from **£14,450** last year

That's **£105** per child

Total expenditure **£25,000**

Profit for events **£8,000** (including Gift Aid)

Donated almost **£12,000** to the school

That's **£60** per child

Funds available **£4,000**
