### Vice-Chair

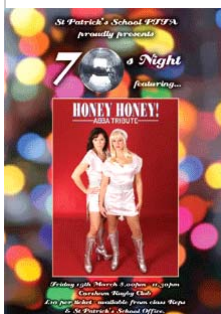
We will be electing our new Vice-Chair at the next PTFA meeting. Please speak to Sarah, Paul or Helen if you would like further information.
